## **SUMMARY OF DUTIES:**

To oversee and maintain the grounds, facilities, birds and animals of the Bird Sanctuary and Children's Farm.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

(These set out the principal functions of the position, and shall not be considered as a detailed description of all the work requirements.)

- 1. Feed, maintain, and generally care for the animals of the Children's Farm.
- 2. Feed, maintain the environment for and generally care for the wild birds in the sanctuary.
- 3. Maintenance of turf, including fertilizing, aerating and over seeding park.
- 4. Maintenance of annual flower beds and horticultural displays.
- 5. Maintenance of herbaceous and woody plant collections including Rhododendrons at the pond area and other unique specimen plantings; including required pruning, propagation and other cultural requirements.
- 6. Using appropriate equipment, maintain the grounds, gardens, buildings, picnic areas, and washrooms.
- 7. Perform minor repairs on buildings and equipment.
- 8. Oversee the security of the property.
- 9. Ensure equipment is safe to operate, securely stored and practice good housekeeping of vehicle and work area.
- 10. Assist the Supervisor in overseeing and providing direction to Gardiner I's, seasonal staff and students.
- 11. Provide excellent customer service including: interacting with the general public and providing insight and information on the site's unique horticultural and animal collections, and responding to needs of all customers and staff as required.
- 12. Efficiently and accurately complete paperwork (e.g. daily performance logs, time sheets and accident reports).
- 13. Perform other similar and related duties as required.

## **POSITION REQUIREMENTS:**

- Grade 12 Diploma or General Educational Development (GED) Certificate.
- Post-secondary diploma in horticulture or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Working knowledge of IPM (Integrated Pest Management).
- Valid Standard First Aid / CPR C Certification as recognized through the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB).
- Valid, unrestricted Class "G" driver's licence (standard and automatic transmission) held in good standing.
- Formal training and experience with the Occupational Health and Safety Act in particular as it relates to maintenance and construction activities (e.g. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), fall arrest, trench safety).
- A demonstrated commitment to enhancing a safety culture. Knowledge of City of St. Catharines safety policies preferred.
- Demonstrated knowledge of the Ontario Traffic Manual with emphasis on Book 7 preferred.
  Ability to safely set up traffic control in work zones during roadway or utility construction and maintenance operations.
- Good basic knowledge and experience in the care and maintenance of turf, plant material, and farm animals; and a genuine interest in parks, horticulture, animals and birds.
- Good basic skills in the use of light truck, farm tractor, hand and power tools for grounds, buildings and equipment repair.
- Ability to meet the physical demands of the job as described in the physical demands analysis (PDA).
- Availability to work flexible hours (e.g. working shifts for a 7 day operation and overtime)
- Effective time management skills and attention to detail with the ability to organize work to meet deadlines, multi-task and work independently in situations with minimal supervision.
- Exceptional customer service skills with a strong sense of public service and cooperation, and well developed abilities to deal with the public and citizens' groups.
- Ability to work with, provide direction to, and support all staff while fostering an inclusive and respectful workplace.
- Basic computer skills, experience with Microsoft Office Suite an asset.
