SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

To perform maintenance and repair services of the municipal water and sewer distribution system and satisfy Provincial requirements for Certified Operators of Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection Systems.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

(These set out the principal functions of the position, and shall not be considered as a detailed description of all the work requirements.)

- 1. Organize, direct and participate in crews of up to 5 workers including machine operators, to perform work related to the maintenance and repair of the City water and sewer distribution system. Sample tasks and duties include:
 - a. Repair, replacement, installation, maintenance and operation of municipal watermain and sewer pipe sections, services, water valves, fire hydrants, catch basins, manholes and culverts:
 - b. Responsibility for proper set-up of required traffic control at work sites to ensure public and worker safety according to City traffic plans, Ministry of Labour (MOL) regulations, and Ministry of Transportation (MOT) guidelines;
 - c. Responsibility for public and crew safety, and the protection of public utility plant when excavating adjacent to high voltage hydro installations, high pressure gas mains and services, fibre optics, etc.;
 - d. Locating sewer and water lines using technical drawings, water and sewer reference books and electronic locating equipment;
 - e. Inspection of watermain valves, fire hydrants, sewers, manholes, overflows and catch basins;
 - f. Personally accountable for ensuring that the Ministry of Labour regulations are followed by all employees on their job site.
- 2. Operate water and sewer installation and maintenance equipment. These include: electric and manual watermain tapping devices, underground piercing tools, compressors, hydraulic valve turning equipment, sewer flushing and rodding equipment, jackhammer, compressor,

- etc. Operate other equipment as trained and qualified such as: sewer flush truck, backhoe, mobile crane, catch basin cleaning truck, etc.
- 3. The ability to deal effectively with the public during emergency and potentially stressful situations, i.e. loss of water, sewer back-ups, etc.
- 4. Carry out minor repairs and maintenance of equipment and tools.
- 5. Assist in directing outside contractors involved in completing City maintenance or utility replacement projects.
- 6. Complete paper work related to daily performance logs, material consumed, preparation of cost and time estimates, etc.
- 7. Ensure equipment is safe to operate, securely stored and practice good housekeeping of vehicle and work area.
- 8. Provide excellent customer service; respond to needs of all customers and staff as required.
- 9. Perform other similar and related duties as required.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade 12 Diploma or General Educational Development (GED) Certificate.
- Presently hold and maintain a minimum of Level 1 MOE Operator Certification in both Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection.
- Certified to operate a Radial Boom Derrick Crane to 8 ton capacity.
- Valid Standard First Aid / CPR C Certification as recognized through the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB).
- Valid, unrestricted Class "DZ" driver's licence held in good standing.
- Annual participation in training and study towards obtaining and maintaining Level 4 MOE Operator Certification in both Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection.
- Formal training and experience with the Occupational Health and Safety Act in particular as
 it relates to excavation and trench safety, confined space entry and traffic control.
- Knowledge of Municipal Plumbing Codes and internal plumbing installations, and / or willingness to attend training sessions pertaining to plumbing and installations.
- Demonstrated knowledge of the Ontario Traffic Manual with emphasis on Book 7 preferred.
 Ability to safely set up traffic control in work zones during roadway or utility construction and maintenance operations.
- A demonstrated commitment to enhancing a safety culture. Knowledge of City of St. Catharines safety policies preferred.
- Ability to meet the physical demands of the job as described in the physical demands analysis (PDA).
- Availability to work flexible hours (e.g. working shifts for a 7 day, 24 hour operation, overtime, winter control).
- Ability to direct and organize other workers while working under limited supervision.

- Effective time management skills and attention to detail with the ability to organize work to meet deadlines, multi-task and work independently in situations with minimal supervision.
- Exceptional customer service skills with a strong sense of public service and cooperation, and well developed abilities to deal with the public and citizens' groups.
- Basic computer skills, experience with Microsoft Office Suite an asset.
